# **Instrument Care**

Please make sure your band equipment is clearly marked with your name. Clean your instrument monthly, and use the appropriate care products. Clean mouthpieces regularly.

- <u>Flute:</u> Cleaning swab and/or rod, cleaning cloth
- <u>Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, Saxophones:</u> Cleaning swab, cork grease, and at least 2 extra reeds (size 2.5)
- <u>Trumpet, F Horn:</u> Valve oil, slide grease, cleaning snake, cleaning cloth
- <u>Euphonium, Tuba:</u> Valve oil
- <u>Trombone</u>: Slide *cream*, tuning slide grease, spray bottle cleaning cloth
- <u>Percussionists</u>: 2B drum sticks, yarn wrapped marimba mallets and a stick bag. Label everything!

#### **Classroom Rules**

The following skills fall under this standard. Various assessments and assignments will be used throughout the year to determine your skills in this area.

- Sight reading How well can you read and perform music you have seen for the first time?
- <u>Technique</u> How well do you know your scales and rhythms? Which instrument-specific skills are you gradually showing improvement in?
- <u>Musicality</u> How well do you use dynamics, articulations, and phrasing in your playing? How well do you blend and balance with your section and the entire band?
- <u>Musical Knowledge</u> How well do you understand form and structure in the music we are playing? Do you know the musical terms that are indicated in your music?
- **Ensemble Musicianship** *The following skills fall under this standard:* 
  - <u>Concerts and Performances</u> We perform throughout the year in formal concerts, school assemblies, and in-class recitals.
  - <u>Execution of Performance music</u> How well do you know the music that we are performing as a group or small ensemble?
- 3. **Daily Work** *The following skills fall under this standard:* 
  - <u>In-class assignments</u> We have various assignments that need to be completed and returned so you can receive feedback on your learning.

#### 4. **Classroom Behaviors** *The following skills fall under this standard:*

- <u>Participation, Effort, and Preparedness</u> Students will be checked daily to make sure they have their instrument, music and necessary accessories.
- <u>Correspondence and communication</u> Students will have permission forms, concert reminders, and other forms of communication that must return to school with a parent signature.
