Although the graduation ceremony is not a requirement, we strongly encourage each student to participate in this formal and dignified ceremony in the presence of family, friends, and staff. Diploma covers will be issued during the graduation ceremony. The diplomas may be picked up at the high school office Monday, June 9 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Diplomas for Running Start students will not be available until we receive grades from WVC.

If this activity does not fit you personally and you choose not to participate, we will present your diploma in an informal manner in the high school office Monday, June 9. Please notify me immediately if you do not plan to participate in the ceremony.
