5. Please contact Mr. or Mrs. Chalmers if you need assistance in acquiring an instrument.

Concert Attire – Must be worn to each performance (please plan ahead)

Music students will be provided a Cashmere Music polo shirt to use for our performances. Students are responsible to return these at the end of the year or they will be charged a \$25 replacement fee.

At the beginning of the school year, please prepare for the required concert attire:

- Black Shoes, Black Socks, Black Dress Pants/Skirt (As nice as possible!)
- Contact Mr. or Mrs. Chalmers if you have problems obtaining correct concert attire.

Instrument Care

Please make sure your band equipment is clearly marked with your name. Clean your instrument monthly, and use the appropriate care products. Clean mouthpieces regularly.

- Flute: Cleaning swab and/or rod, cleaning cloth
- Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, Saxophones: Cleaning swab, cork grease, and at least 2 extra reeds (size 2.5).
- Trumpet, F Horn: Valve oil, slide grease, cleaning snake, cleaning cloth.
- Euphonium, Tuba: Valve oil
- Trombone: Slide *cream*, tuning slide grease, spray bottle cleaning cloth.
- Percussionists: 2B drum sticks, yarn wrapped marimba mallets and a stick bag. Label everything!

Classroom Rules

- Listen and follow directions
- Raise hand to talk or to get of your seat
- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Respect the teacher, classmates and yourself
- All rules outlined in the middle school student handbook apply to band class.

ASSESSMENT/REPORTING

Students will be assessed on their skills within the following four standards:

1. **Individual Musicianship:**

The following skills fall under this standard. Various assessments and assignments will be used throughout the year to determine your skills in this area.

- Sight reading – How well can you read and perform music you have seen for the first time?
- Technique – How well do you know your scales and rhythms? Which instrument-specific skills are you gradually showing improvement in?
- Musicality – How well do you use dynamics, articulations, and phrasing in your playing? How well do you blend and balance with your section and the entire band?
- Musical Knowledge – How well do you understand form and structure in the music we are playing? Do you know the musical terms that are indicated in your music?

2. **Ensemble Musicianship**

The following skills fall under this standard:

- Concerts and Performances – We perform throughout the year in formal concerts, school assemblies, and in-class recitals.
- Execution of Performance music – How well do you know the music that we are performing as a group or small ensemble?

3. **Daily Work and Practice**

The following skills fall under this standard:

- Assigned practice – Students may need to practice extra at home.
- In class assignments – We have various assignments that need to be completed and returned so you can receive feedback on your learning.

4. **Classroom Behaviors**

The following skills fall under this standard:

- Participation, Effort, and Preparedness – Students will be checked daily to make sure they have their instrument, music and necessary accessories.
- Correspondence and communication – Students will have permission forms, concert reminders, and other forms of communication that must return to school with a parent signature.
