STUDENT APPLICATIONS

The Cashmere Rotary Club will be offering scholarships for higher education once again to the graduating class of 2021.

In the past we have been able to announce how many scholarships will be awarded and in what amount. Due to current circumstances because of Covid-19, we have been unable to meet as a club since March and have had to cancel our normal fundraising activities. Our annual Rotary auction held every November, has been the primary source of funding for both Cashmere Cares and Student Scholarships. Since we were unable to have the auction this year, we are now engaged in alternative plans to fund both programs but do not know what resources will be available for distribution until late spring. Our goal is to move forward and offer what we can at that time.

The applications presented offer a choice of three different opportunities for which you may apply but YOU MAY ONLY APPLY FOR ONE OF THE THREE:

- 1. ACADEMIC: this category will be an assessment of the prospects for future success in a career field that requires a higher education.**
- 2. CHALLENGE: this category is not unlike the Academic requirements but includes a question of what specific challenges you faced in your life and dealt with on your way to be able to advance to a higher level of education.**
- 3. VOCATIONAL/TECH: If your post- graduation plans include choosing a field that requires a two-year training and/or educational program or anything that does not require a four-year degree this is the suitable scholarship.**

Each scholarship awarded will be paid directly to the institution or school in which you will enroll. Those awarded a scholarship will be notified at a future date. You will have two years to claim your scholarship (A request for an extension must be in writing to the Cashmere Rotary Board, P.O. Box 821, Cashmere).

All applications are due back to the counselor's office no later than APRIL 1st.
