

COMMITTEES

There shall be no permanent standing committees. All advisory committees are appointed for a specific purpose and shall be automatically discharged as soon as the special function has been served. Committee action is not official until the board has passed upon it in a regular or special meeting.

Actions of the advisory committee shall be advisory and such action shall not reduce the responsibility of the board for policies adopted, the administration of the schools by the superintendent and staff. The board shall be free to accept recommendations as it sees fit.
