Dear Parents, Staff and Community Members –

At 1:30 pm this afternoon, Governor Inslee issued an executive order closing all public and private schools in an effort to effectively slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus. The Cashmere School District will be closed beginning Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> through at least April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

This decision is certainly not something we take lightly, and we haven't had much time to process all that the closure entails. With this unprecedented closure of schools, there is much to consider such as:

- How might we continue working together to provide learning experiences outside of the school?
- How might we continue to provide food service/meals for our children?
- How might we work with our community partners to continue to provide child care for medical professionals and working families?

Administration and staff are working collaboratively to answer these questions and so many more. While we do not have all the answers right now, I can assure you that the Cashmere School District staff and administration are committed to continuing to provide quality services for our students and families during this very difficult time.
