## CASHMERE SCHOOL DISTRICT #222 Regular Board Meeting December 17, 2018

Call to Order: Chairman Tom Christensen called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M.

Declaration of Quorum: Board members Ted Snodgrass, Paul Nelson and Nicholas Woods were present. There were five others present including Business Manager, Angela Allred. Superintendent Johnson was absent.

- 1.0 <u>Flag Salute</u> Chairman Tom Christensen led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2.0 <u>Approval of the Agenda</u> On a motion by Vice-Chairman Ted Snodgrass, the Board approved the agenda as revised.

## 3.0 <u>Reports, Correspondence and Program</u>

- 3.1 <u>Board Report</u> Board member Paul Nelson joyfully indicated it was almost Christmas Break!
- 3.2 <u>Student Leadership Report</u> CHS students, Riley Yonaka and Daniel Moreno, were present to update the Board on current events. These events included a nacho feed for Spanish Club and both girls' and boys' basketball games happening this week. They also reminded the Board of Christmas Break!

## 3.3 <u>Superintendent Report</u>

- 3.3.1 <u>6th Grade Wrestling</u> Athletic Director, Jeff Carlson, was present to speak to the Board about new information from the WIAA concerning the wrestling program. Last spring, the WIAA passed an amendment for 6<sup>th</sup> grade wrestlers to participate with and against seventh and eighth graders. He added that most schools in our NCW middle school league are moving forward with allowing 6<sup>th</sup> graders to wrestle starting this winter. Mr. Carlson went on to state this would not increase our budget in any way as the district has enough uniforms and coaches to accommodate the additional numbers, expected to be about 10-15 new athletes.
- 3.3.2 <u>Construction Update</u> HS Principal, Tony Boyle, was present to update the Board on the construction progress in the building. He stated he was shocked to see how much has happened in the last few weeks with carpet and furniture being delivered the following week. He added the HVAC system is working and lights are in as well. The crews have been working through weekends and are expected to work through the holiday break. Mr. Boyle added the kids seem unfazed by this entire process.

- 3.3.3 <u>Budget/Enrollment Update</u> Business Manager, Ms. Allred, reported that district enrollment was down one student overall in December, but Vale's enrollment had increased. She stated she would be keeping a close eye on this area in planning for next year's budget.
- 3.3.4 <u>2019 Legislative Session</u> Business Manager, Angela Allred, updated the Board with details on the upcoming 2019 Legislative Session. This year's session will be held February 10-11. Topics of discussion include education finance and implementation of the new system. Both Legislative Representative, Paul Nelson, and Ms. Allred indicated their plan to attend again this year.
