February 8, 2021

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Tom Christensen called the meeting to order at 7:00 AM.

DECLARATION OF QUORUM:

Board members Roger Perleberg, Ted Snodgrass and Nicholas Wood were present. Board member Paul Nelson was absent. There were two others present including Superintendent Johnson.

1.0 Flag Salute

1.1. Chairman Christensen led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2.0 Approval of the Agenda – On a motion by Roger Perleberg, the Board approved the agenda as presented.

3.0 Reports, Correspondence and Program –

3.1. Board Report – There was no board report.

3.2. Superintendent's Report –

3.2.1. Enrollment Update – Superintendent Johnson gave a brief update on enrollment. He stated the district is currently up about five or six students over what was budgeted. Superintendent Johnson stated this is as expected with many of our students beginning to reenroll.

3.2.2. Winter Student Conferences – Feb 24<sup>th</sup> – Superintendent Johnson spoke to the Board about the upcoming conferences planned for Feb., 24<sup>th</sup>. These conferences will be targeted for those students that are struggling but also open to any parent who request one. Superintendent Johnson also spoke briefly about the upcoming 2021-22 school year calendar and the importance of keeping the conferences before the start of school year, as parent feedback on this has been very positive.

3.2.3. WIAA Update – Superintendent Johnson stated there is still much uncertainty in this area as the district is not sure what will happen given the requirement for our region to be in Phase 2 of the Governor's "Roadmap to Recovery" plan in order to move forward with our sports program.

3.2.4. 2020 Census – Potential Redistricting – Superintendent Johnson communicated he had recently received a letter from Census in regards to a potential redistricting. Census looks at each School District and reevaluates numbers to see if there is a need for redistricting board members and adjusting boundary lines.

3.2.5 HS Principal Posting/Hiring Process – Superintendent Johnson stated HS Principal Tony Boyle recently announced his retirement. He stated he had already met with the HS staff in preparation of this upcoming new hire. Superintendent Johnson added an all staff survey would also be going out very soon in regards to this transition. Superintendent Johnson stated the district is currently working to create a posting that will remain open for at least a month.

4.0 Visitors – There were no visitors.

5.0 Adjournment – On a motion by Vice-Chairman Ted Snodgrass and there being no further business to discuss, Chairman Christensen adjourned the meeting at 7:41 AM.
