## I am ready to go back to school when...

Fever free without the assistance of medication for 24 hrs. (Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Motrin, Advil)	Free from vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hrs.	Cough is well controlled (resolving) and breathing comfortably	After 24 hrs. of antibiotic treatment, eye no longer oozing or eye has cleared out	Free from rash, itching, sores are dry, or could be cover with by a bandage, or with orders from DR	School has orders from DR. Please work with school nurse to address special health care so student may attend safely

Home is best place for a student who is ill. If your student is sick with a diagnosed communicable disease (this would include influenza or COVID-19), please notify the school as soon as possible. This notification will greatly assist others who, due to medical reasons and/or treatments, have weakened immune systems and may require immediate and specialized care.

If your student has strep throat or another bacterial infection, student must stay home until the antibiotic has been given for at least 24 hours and your health care provider has given permission for your child to return to school.
