They . . . see you when you're sleeping, They . . . know when you're awake

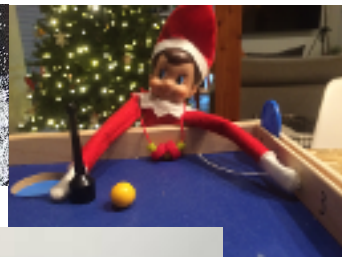
They . . . know if you've been bad or good, so be good for goodness sake.
