There's more to bringing them back:

- Breaks will be given at teachers' discretion
- Movement around the school will be limited
- 4 period schedule w/ 2 classes a day
- Independent work to be done at home
- No lockers this year
- No water fountain use, bring a water bottle
- PE/Band/Choir/AVID/ELL/Title will remain asynchronous



Limit the amount of material your student brings to school each day. They will have to carry their backpack.

Tip

Please do **not** send your student to school if they are sick.

Wash their masks regularly.

Have your child practice wearing a mask for longer periods at a time.

Health & Safety Requirements

- Face Masks Required (including parents & visitors while on campus)
 gators & bandanas not approved
- Student Self-Attestation Agreement needs to be completed Prior to 1st Day
 - \circ Available online or at materials pick-up
 - Daily Screening at Home by Parents
 - Screening log sent to school daily
- Daily Screening at School by Staff
- Regular Hand Washing
- Physical Distancing 6 feet
- Students with 1 or more COVID Symptom will be sent home (CDHD and Confluence Guidance)
- Consistent cleaning and disinfecting of surfaces



Food Service

Another tricky problem to solve but important service we provide our CMS students:

→ What

Lunch & Breakfast DAILY.

→ Who

Any student that wants or needs it.

→ When

Students will not eat at school but they will bring their food home with them.

We will need to know your TRANSPORTATION plans. Will your student be taking a bus or getting to school by other means?



Safety First

- Buses & vans will be cleaned between routes.
- Students will social distance to the best of their ability.
- Sibling groups will be asked to sit together.
- Masks will be required to board a bus.

We need some information from you.

Will your student be returning to CMS @ school?

Will your student be a bus rider?

Will your student be receiving food services?

Homeroom teachers will be reaching out to get this information from families.



Note

CMS @home families can join CMS @school at any time.

Specifics on the timing of students returning to in person instruction will include teacher input.

CMS @home

CMS @home will continue to be an option for families.

We won't know who will be our CMS @ home teacher(s) until we get a better idea of how many students will be opting for @ home.

Our current plans for CMS @home are not finalized but will include some form of online live instruction.

CMS Students with COVID like symptoms

The @home learning numbers will impact what our quarantine instruction looks like. Each situation is handled on a case by case basis in consultation with the district nurse and the CDHD.

However, we are committed to providing quality instruction to our students while they are out on quarantine.
